Can your group support Capuchin Community Services as we help those in need this holiday season?

We are holding Holiday Gift Box and Christmas Toy Drives this year. Here's how your group can help:

Holiday Gift Boxes

Capuchin Community Services provides food boxes to 1,000 senior households for Thanksgiving and 1,000 family households at Christmas. Qualifying guests are served at our two sites, the House of Peace and St. Ben's Community Meal.

Many guests served at the Meal at St. Ben's have access to a kitchen but don't always have food. Many of those served by the House of Peace are working people who have to rely on our Emergency Food Pantry to help feed their families.

We provide food boxes with a shopping list printed on it. Your group holds a food drive. The food box "packing event" works with groups of all ages and abilities.

A detailed shopping list is printed on the back of this flyer. For donated food boxes, the House of Peace adds a gift card to help pay for perishable foods and a turkey.

Toy Drive

The 1,000 households that sign up for the Christmas Holiday Gift Boxes include 2-3 children each. We are seeking gifts of new, unwrapped toys for children ages birth to 10 years of age, boys & girls. A detailed shopping list is printed on the back of this flyer. Gifts and/or gift cards should

be delivered to the House of Peace site no later than 2 weeks prior to Christmas.

Gift Cards for Food or Toys

- **Holiday Supermarket Gift Cards**, distributed during November and December. Supermarket gift cards are accepted in any amount. One box for a family, with turkey and all the fixings, is valued at \$50. Roundy's Metro Market and Pick 'N Save serve many of our guests. Cards are welcome in any amount up to \$50. Please use a check for gifts over \$50.
- **Holiday Toy Drive or Gift Cards**, distributed during the two weeks before Christmas. Major retailers like WalMart or Target are accessible to most guests.

Please donate one or more canned or boxed goods to help complete a Holiday Meal Box for a needy family. Capuchin Community Services will distribute food boxes to guests served at two sites: House of Peace & St. Ben's Community Meal. Please bring the items on:

- 1 box of mashed potatoes
- 1 bag of stuffing
- 1 box of cake mix
- 1 can of frosting
- 4 cans of green beans
- 4 cans of corn
- 2 boxes of pudding or Jell-O
- 2 boxes of cornbread mix
- 2 boxes of macaroni and cheese
- 2 cans of cranberry sauce
- 1 32 oz. can of sweet potatoes or yams
- 1 can of gravy (No glass jars, please)
